The Street Orphans of Rwanda



You have an opportunity to directly impact the lives of the poorest of Africa's poor. And the most vulnerable.

These are the street orphans of Rwanda

- ✧ Orphans whose parents and family were killed in the 1994 Genocide
- ✧ Orphans whose parents have died of AIDS
- ✧ Orphans of poverty whose families have no resources to care for them

These children are street kids who have nothing and exist, literally, from day to day.

El Shaddai Orphanage Kigali, Rwanda

400 street kids have been brought together in an unfinished warehouse to form El Shaddai Orphanage. It is struggling to provide shelter, education, security, clothing, health care and food to these children.

The orphanage will be forced to move to a new location in the future. Help is needed to purchase the land and build the new site.

Until the new location can be developed, there are many immediate needs at the existing orphanage:

- More funding for food to feed more of the street kids
- More beds, blankets, mattresses and sheets
- School supplies – paper, chalk, text books, exercise books, pens, pencils, crayons, black boards
- Medicine for the dispensary
- More money to pay the teachers and other people who work at the orphanage
- Screening material to keep out insects
- Clothes of all sizes for the children
- More sewing machines for the sewing classes
- A bigger generator and more lights in the classrooms
- At least one full-time English teacher
- A vehicle – preferably a pickup truck
- Recreational equipment
